## ARTICLE 2-9

3	Consultation with President. The president or the president's
4	representativesProvost shall meet with-the local UFF Chapter representatives to
5	discuss matters pertinent to the implementation implementing or
6	administering ration of this Agreement, University actions affecting terms and
7	conditions of employment, or any other mutually agreeable matters. Such meetings
8	shall normally occur at least once (1) each semester in the academic year and once
9	(1) during the summer term unless the parties mutually agree to meet more
10	frequently. Each party shall submit a written list of agenda items at least two weeks
11	in advance of before the meeting. If neither party wishes to place items on the
12	agenda, then both parties can agree that no consultation is needed that semester.
13	If an issue arises that either party wishes to address separately from a formal
14	consultation, after an attempt at informal resolution, that party shall have the
15	ability to call an additional -consultation in an attempt to resolve that single issue.
16	Either party may request a consultation. If no request is made for a consultation
17	during any given semester or summer term, as applicable, then the consultation for
18	that semester or the summer term, as applicable, is waived. The party requesting
19	consultation shall submit a written list of agenda items at least two weeks in
20	advance of the meeting. The other party may add to that agenda by submitting a
21	written list of agenda items to the party calling for the consultation at least the day
22	before the meeting if it wishes to discuss specific issues.
23	Consultations may be used to resolve problems regarding the implementation and
24	administration of the Agreement. The parties understand and agree that such
25	meetings consultations shall not constitute or be used for the purpose of collective
26	bargaining, to discussing specific grievances, or to modifying, adding to, or
27	deleting any provision of this Agreement. However, grievances that are closed and

are no longer subject to the provisions of Article 20 may be discussed.
